The oldest of three, Robbie always put pressure on himself to be the leader of the family and to set a good example for his siblings.
- ③ His parents both were huge inspirations in his musical life. Robbie's mom loved singing and his father played drums and guitar.
- ③ Once he got out of high school he started writing songs for major latin pop artists, eventually working with artists like Daddy Yankee. Once the producers heard his voice, they encouraged him to sing, and he started singing backup and touring with them. Through his writing, he has had some incredible experiences as a performer—like singing in front of 50,000 people.
- ③ He thrives under pressure and has had to learn songs just hours before a live performance.
- ③ Robbie is self taught and grew up mimicking idols like George Michael, Michael Jackson and Freddie Mercury in lieu of an education.
- ③ He's faced challenges as a queer artist and songwriter, not always feeling like he belongs. While progress has been made, Robbie still feels there is a ton of work left when it comes to queer representation in music and he hopes to be a part of it.
