- ⌚ Savannah's YouTube page took off after her viral performance of "Breaking Free" from *High School Musical*. She went from a few thousand subscribers to 700,000, and that's when she knew she was headed in the right direction.

There were countless near record deals and too many "nos" to count, but through it all Savannah has kept an upbeat spirit and relentless determination.
