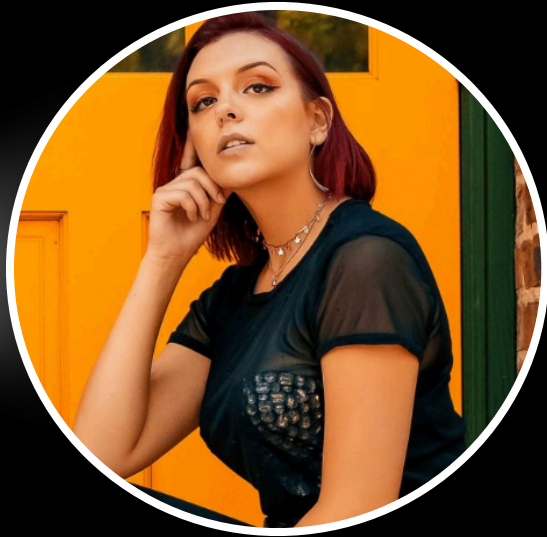

ABOUT

Deza grew up in both Georgia and Houston, and took her love of music wherever she went. She was in a family quartet growing up, and as soon as she could talk, she was already singing. Nothing was going to get in her way, and once she was old enough, she started entering competitions and competing in choir. After dropping out of college to pursue music in Norway, Deza has returned stateside ready to share what she's learned from the hitmakers overseas.



THE DETAILS

- Deza grew up in Georgia until she was 11, then moved to Houston. She was raised in a musical family – Deza, her mom, dad and older sister all used to sing in a quartet at their church. Her grandpa was an organist, choir director and music theory teacher, and her grandmother was in choir for decades. In kindergarten, if Deza wasn't humming in class, the teacher would ask her mom if she was feeling okay.
- From a young age, it was clear that music was the thing Deza loved most, and she excelled at it. She took any opportunity to be on stage, submitting to any and all competitions to prove she belonged. Her first music memory was in pre-school when she got her classmates to line up so that she could conduct her own choir.
- She competed classically in high school, and made the Texas all-state choir three out of four years. She worked so hard that she even suffered vocal damage and had to be completely silent for four weeks. Against her doctor's orders, Deza sang at All-State auditions before she was technically allowed to sing again.
- Her most rewarding music experience was when she dropped out of Belmont University to study music for a year in Lillehammer, Norway. She knew she needed to take a leap of faith and push herself musically – and she found the school LIMPI to study pop music for a year. It was here where she got a publishing deal and it gave her a broadened perspective on the world of music.
- She currently is a songwriter, artist and producer for RX Songs. She works with songwriter Emily Warren, and they are in sessions 4-5 times a week recording music.
