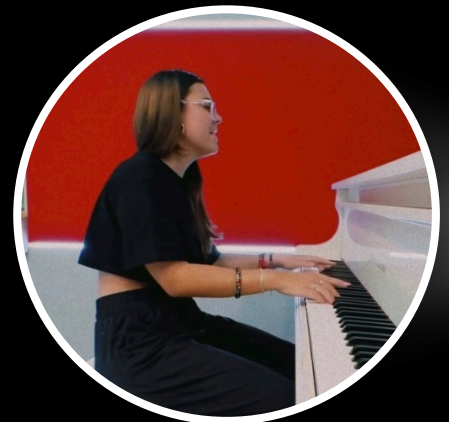
ABOUT

The daughter of a ballerina and music producer, Luiza has spent her entire life around music. In fact, most of her early childhood memories are either at the theater or in the studio. Her family moved to Miami when she was 14 and she's been doing the same things she's done her whole life – enjoy the beach and sing to anyone who will lend an ear.



THE DETAILS

- ③ Music is in Luiza's DNA, and it spans generations. Her grandparents are Brazilian music royalty – her grandma is a famous singer and her grandpa is one of the most famous bassists in all of Brazil. Because of this, she spent a lot of time around professional musicians and was inspired to pursue music herself. Her life changed at age 12 when she submitted for *La Voz Kids* in Brazil.
- ③ On the show, young Luiza did what her family has always been known for – she delivered on a big stage. She made it all the way to the semifinals, and even after she was eliminated her judge – famous Brazilian singer Ivete Sangalo – she still had the chance to sing a duet with him on stage. Shortly after, she took a step back from music and went back to just being a kid, but it always was an integral part of her life. After moving to Miami at 14, she started getting back into performing and found joy in starting completely over in the US.
- ③ Luiza currently works as a teacher at a performing arts school and loves her students dearly. She considers herself part-teacher/part-therapist since her students always go to her when they need help. They call her "Ms. Luiza" and see her as just another friend since she's so young, and Luiza loves nurturing their talent and pushing them to be the best.
- ③ Luiza has more experience in the music industry at 21 than a lot of people have in a lifetime. But that hasn't stopped her from pushing to continue to pursue a dream that started as a girl. As an adult, she's hoping she didn't miss her one opportunity to become a musical success – and Luiza feels this could be one of her last opportunities to seize the limelight and show the industry what she is made of.
